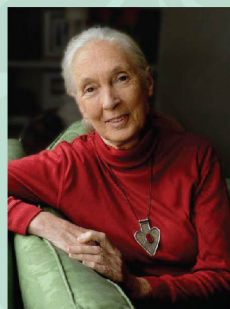
English for Environment

Program Features

1. “English For Environment” (6 – 8 hours In-school Education Program)

Education officer(s) from The Jane Goodall Institute Hong Kong will provide each school a 6 – 8 hours “English For Environment” in-school education program. In this program, our English speaking officer(s) will teach students (10 – 15 students/ school) environmental issues like climate change, global warming, sustainable development etc via games and site visits using English.

2. The Green Carnival

After the completion of the 6-8 hours learning program, assisted by our education officer, students will need to design and run a game booth (Green Carnival) for their school during recess and lunch time in English to sharing their learning experience with their friends and classmates.

3. The Green School Network

Schools participated in the English for Environment will be included into The Green School Network which is an online platform managed by The Jane Goodall Institute (Hong Kong). In the platform, schools can share their Green Carnival , and experience on environmental education with other schools. E-newsletter will also published monthly to all the member schools.
